SCOOBY DOOBY DIALOGUE

Requirements

- Create a dialogue inspired by the show Scooby Doo. Your dialogue must include use of the present progressive tense, commands, indirect object pronouns and direct objects by each group member.
- A single typed script with the above requirements highlighted in a different color for each group member.
- 5 lines (sentences of 5 words or more) per person.
- No reading the script! Memorize your lines or use cue cards visible from the back of the room or the camera position, if filming. Keep it simple. Don't try to speak above your ability—above your classmates' ability to understand and enjoy!
- Avoid repetition or filler. You should sound dramatic or at least conversational, not contrived.
- Bonus points for costumes, props, and effects.

You will be scored on:

- script (format, line length, and language requirements mentioned above)
- understandability (use of familiar vocabulary and grammar)
- dramatic expression (facial expression, tone of voice, gestures, etc.)
