


# PROYECTO PAÍS

## STEP ONE

Using a piece of foamboard or cardboard, draw and cut out the shape of your assigned country—the bigger, the better! It should be at least 200 square inches in area (about the size of a 14x14 square). Hint: make a paper template and attach it to the board before cutting. You can trace the enlarged image of your country from a computer screen.

## STEP TWO

Find out exactly where the capital is and draw or glue a star on your cutout to indicate its location.

## STEP THREE
